This play-based preschool program at Eola and Prisco community centers and Vaughan Athletic Center embraces our STEAM-based curriculum and ensures kindergarten readiness while utilizing the benefits of the community center. Indoor and outdoor time will promote expression, creative, problem-solving, group work and motor skill development.

NATURE PLAY PRESCHOOL

Based on a kindergarten readiness and STEAM curriculum, Nature Play preschool at Blackberry Farm and Red Oak Nature Center emphasizes environmental educational, nature investigation, recycling and conservation. Outdoor time every day (weather dependent) is a core feature of this program.

STEAM CURRICULUM

Our STEAM curriculum builds learners for life, rich in science, math and art activities that follow the Illinois Early Learning Standards.

REGISTRATION (2019-20)

Registration must be done in-person at one of our community centers. Please bring a copy of your child's birth certificate and proof of residency. A non-refundable \$75 registration fee is due at the time of registration.

Jan. 7: Registration packets available

Jan. 14: Registration for all returning students/siblings

Jan. 21: Resident registration open to new students

Jan. 28: Non-resident registration open to new students

Classes begin in September. Parents will receive specific start dates and class information in August.

AGE REQUIREMENTS (2019-20)

Students must meet the following age requirements on or before Sept. 1, 2019:

- 2-year-old program: 30 months
- 3-year-old program: 3 years
- 4-year-old and Pre-K programs: 4 years

TUITION OPTIONS

- Pay annual tuition in full for the entire year at time of registration
- Monthly Electronic Fund Transfers (EFTs) for monthly tuition payments straight from a checking, savings or credit account.
