

Private Aquatic Rentals FAQs

How do I book a private pool party?

Send a completed Aquatics Reservation Request or check availability at vacreservations@fvpd.net. Once availability is confirmed you will be contacted to pay a refundable deposit of \$150. The deposit will be refunded after the rental, provided there are no violations of the agreement. The balance is due 14 days prior to party.

When do you offer private pool rentals?

Saturdays and Sundays 5:30-7:30pm, additional hour(s) can be added.

Can we get in early?

The party rental is from 5:30-7:30 p.m., which includes your set up and tear down time. You will have access to the room at 5:30 p.m., so please plan accordingly. The guards will blow the whistle at 7:15 p.m. to give people time to dry off, change clothes and gather their belongings.

How many guests can I have?

The leisure pool has a maximum of 225 guests, the competition pool has a maximum of 225 guests, and the leisure and competition pool combined has a maximum of 450 guests. All guests must sign a waiver at the check in window whether swimming or not.

Do guests need to sign a waiver?

Everyone attending the pool party, whether swimming or not, will need to sign the liability waiver at the check-in window.

What is included in the rental?

Lifeguards on duty for the pool/pools rented and access to the locker rooms are included. The leisure pool rental includes the party room and patio, 18 chairs at tables and 2 tables for serving. The patio is connected to the party room with a door that will be unlocked (please do not prop open). The patio has a banquet table and 5 hexagon tables. Please note: the competition pool-only rental does not include party room or party patio.

What can we bring?

Sealed soft drinks, food, snacks or delivered food are allowed. You will need to supply all paper products, tablecloths and utensils needed. Decorations are allowed, but please do not tape on park district signs. A small speaker is allowed.

What is not allowed?

Absolutely no glass of any kind allowed in the pool area. This includes drink/food containers, diving masks and goggles with glass lenses. No food or drink allowed on the pool deck. No helium balloons; no alcohol or tobacco.

Will there be life jackets available for use?

There are a limited number of life jackets. You may bring your own US Coast Guard Approved life jacket. No other flotation devices allowed.

How deep is the pool?

Leisure Pool: The depth ranges depending on where you are in the pool, zero depth to 4ft. **Competition Pool:** The depth ranges from 4ft to 12ft. The inflatable obstacle course is in the deepest end of the

pool. Anyone wearing a life jacket on the obstacle course must be accompanied by someone 16 years or older.

Does my child need to wear a swim diaper?

Children not yet toilet trained must wear a swim diaper covered by tight fitting shorts or suit.

How tall must you be to ride the tube and body slides?

You must be 48" tall to ride the slides. No goggles or life jackets allowed on the slides. There is a smaller slide in the play/spray area.

Will there be lifeguards on duty?

Lifeguards will be on duty to enforce rules and respond in case of an emergency. Guests are responsible for supervising their attendees.

Please note

Proper and appropriate swim attire must be worn. No towels are provided. Management reserves the right to close the facility due to unsafe conditions. Admission into the facility may be refused to persons with potentially hazardous medical conditions.
