

Splash Away Party FAQs

How many guests does the Splash Away Party Package include?

The package includes 18 guests. All adults and children 2+ attending, swimming or not, are included in the guest count.

Can I bring additional guests?

Additional guests are \$7/each for residents and \$9/each for non-residents. There is a maximum capacity of 25 people in the party room and 30 people on the patio at one time. The host can purchase additional guest tickets at the time of booking or the day of the party. The host must pay for additional guests at Guest Services before the party ends. There are no refunds for unused tickets purchased. Guests can also purchase tickets at the Guest Services desk.

What is included in the package?

- Admission for 18 guests
- Party space for 2.5 hours (party room or party patio)
- Unlimited use of the leisure pool and spray area (Friday 5-8, Saturday and Sunday 12-5)
- Tablecloths on banquet tables, dessert plates, napkins, forks, and cups
- Two pitchers of a soft drink and a pitcher of water (additional soft drinks can be purchased at Guest Services for \$5)
- Printable Party Invitation

Deposit and Payment

A completed contract and the signed rules and regulations page must be submitted to book available dates, a \$75 deposit will also be due once booked. You will receive an email to confirm party details and asked to call 630-907-9600 to pay the balance 10 days prior.

Are decorations allowed?

You can bring decorations, but please do not cover or tape on FVPD signage. No helium balloons are allowed, non-helium balloons are allowed. No pinatas allowed. All decorations must be removed by the end of your party time.

Do guests have to complete the invitation/waiver?

All guests swimming or not will need to sign the waiver upon arrival or turn in the invitation/waiver and receive a wrist band. The invitation/waiver can be completed by the parent/guardian for kids that are carpooling.

Can we bring in drinks and food or have it delivered?

You may bring food and cake or have it delivered; additional plates/napkins will not be provided. Food delivery should be directed to the check-in window next to the pool. Additional sealed soft drinks are allowed. Absolutely no glass of any kind or alcohol allowed. No food allowed on the pool deck.

Will there be life jackets available for use?

There are a limited number of life jackets. You may bring your own US Coast Guard Approved life jacket. No other flotation devices allowed.

How tall must you be to ride the tube and body slides?

You must be 48" tall to ride the slides. No goggles or life jackets allowed on the slides. There is a smaller slide in the play/spray area.

How deep is the pool?

The depth ranges depending on where you are in the pool, zero depth to 4ft.

Are other people at the pool during the party? Are lifeguards on duty?

The pool is open to the public during parties. There will be lifeguards on duty.

Are lockers available? Is there a changing room?

Lockers are available, though you will need to supply your own lock. You have access to the family changing rooms. Locks can be purchased at guest services for \$5.

Does my child need to wear a swim diaper?

Children not yet toilet trained must wear a swim diaper covered by tight fitting shorts or suit. Swim diapers are available at Guest Services for \$2 each.

Pool Hours

Pool hours are Friday from 5 to 8 p.m. and Saturday from 12 to 5 p.m. (Holiday and seasonal hours will be posted)

Party Hours

Party hours are available Friday from 5 to 8 p.m.; Saturday and Sunday 11:30* a.m. to 2 p.m. and 2:30 to 5 p.m. Your party time includes set up and clean up, please plan accordingly. *Parties starting at 11:30 a.m. cannot swim until 12 p.m.
